These are a important items of life-saving equipment and I assure you are very easy to use. You will need to dial 999 to gain access to the locked defibrillator cabinet. It is as easy as switching them on and the machine then talks you through the quick process. If you dialed 999 for an ambulance, the call handler will guide you through Defibrillator locations close to you and how to use them.

Our club also has two defibrillators, one for Wednesday training sessions and the other in our cupboard at the Victoria Club.

Run leaders - please familiarise yourself with their location, and contact me if you are unsure of these. Please take them out to cross-country and club races. Keep them at the start/finish.
