Motion 1

In section 11, to add 'in accordance with the club's formal Grievance and Disciplinary policy,' to the end of sentence one in the second paragraph. This para will now read as follows:

'The management committee will meet to hear complaints within fourteen days of a complaint being lodged, in accordance with the club's formal Grievance and Disciplinary policy. The committee has the power to take appropriate disciplinary action including termination of membership.'

Background:

- In December 2023, the Committee approved a formal Grievance and Disciplinary policy, based on the template provided by England Athletics. This is supported by two more detailed documents providing the Committee with procedural guidance in the event of receiving a formal complaint.
- This should help to ensure that all complaints are dealt with in a consistent, open and transparent manner.
- The emphasis will remain on resolving any concerns raised by members informally whenever possible. The formal grievance and disciplinary procedure should only be used when the member(s) are dissatisfied with the initial response received.

Motion 2

I move that fees for the year 1 April 2024 to 31 March 2025 shall be £15, payable by 12 May 2024.
